



Baptismal Square Pattern

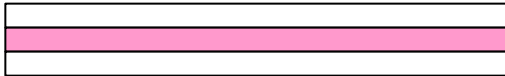
(Makes 2 squares)

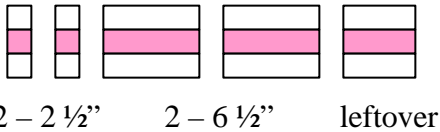

Yardage Needed	1 st Cut	2 nd Cut
Pink or Blue pastel fabric  1/8 yd	1 – 2 1/2" x WOF	2 – 21" x 2 1/2"
White Fabric  7/8 yd	1 – 2 1/2" x WOF 1 – 2 1/2" x WOF 1 – 4 1/2" x WOF 1 – 18" x WOF	2 – 21" x 2 1/2" 2 – 22" x 18"
2 yards pink or blue 1/8" ribbon		

Using the two white strips (2 1/2" x 21") and the one pink/blue strip (2 1/2" x 21") sew as shown:



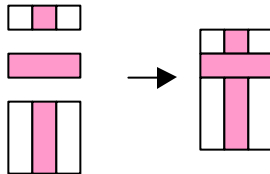
From the strip, cut 2 – 2 1/2" segments, and 2 – 6 1/2" segments. Set aside one of each to use for the next square. We will just be making one right now.



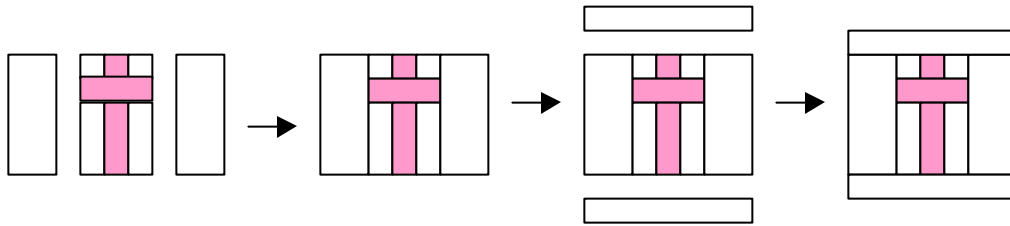
From the other pink/blue strip, cut 2 – 6 1/2" pieces. Set one aside for other square.



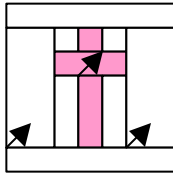
Assemble the cross as shown using the pieces cut.



Now take the 4 ½” white strip and cut two pieces the length of the cross (should be close to 10 ½”) and attach as shown. Next, using the 2 ½” strip of white, cut two pieces the wide of the block. Sew one to the top and the other to the bottom of the square as shown.



Layer with the batting and backing. Finish the edges, with a rolled binding. Put in three bows: One on the center of the cross, the other two in the lower left and right sections.



On the back, written in permanent fabric ink, write the following:

Baby Full Name
Date of Baptism
Church Name
City and State
